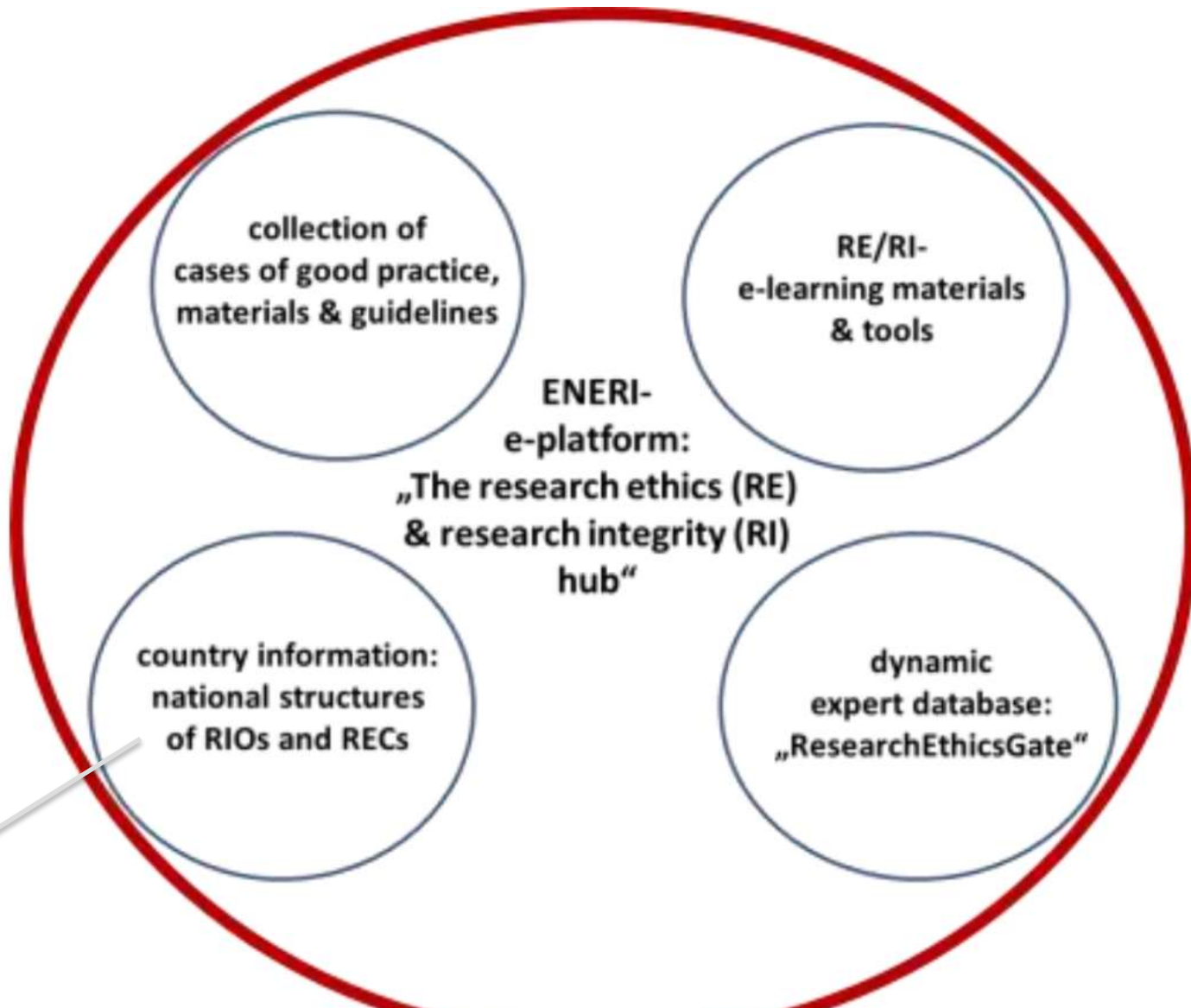

- ALLEA Permanent working group on science and ethics → subgroup (5 people, with Els Van Damme, VCWI)

 - Research Integrity: What it Means, Why it Is Important and How we Might Protect it

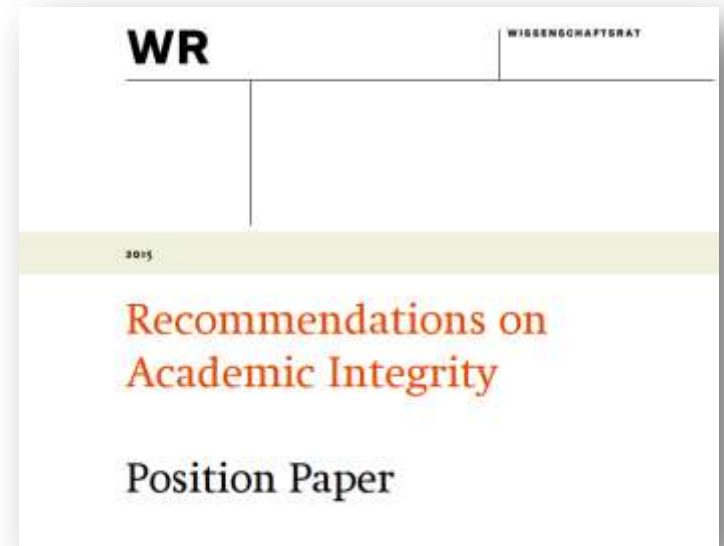
